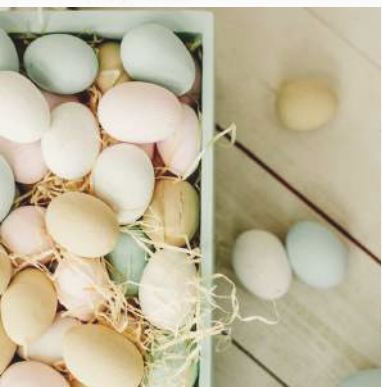




Easter has arrived to Comporta

“Folar”

Discover the legend behind the "folar"

The legend tells the story of Mariana, a young woman who wished to marry early and asked Saint Catherine for help in choosing between two suitors.

When the two men decided to fight for her, Mariana, after praying to the Saint, named the poor farmer instead of the nobleman as her chosen one.

On the day of the wedding, Mariana, her suitor, and the nobleman received identical cakes decorated with flowers and eggs, leading them to believe it was a gift from Saint Catherine, a symbol of reconciliation.

The "folar", initially called "folore", is a symbol of reconciliation and is traditionally offered by godparents to godchildren at Easter.
